**Main Responsibilities (may include but are not limited to):**

- Lead multidisciplinary teams (MDT) during regularly scheduled weekly rounds at various facilities in the assigned region
- Provide wound care services to patients in partner facilities: skilled nursing, assisted living and adult family homes, as well as to home health patients
- Assess patients' health status by reviewing relevant health and medical history
- Order, interpret, and evaluate laboratory and diagnostic studies to assess change to patients' health care needs
- Develop a treatment plan for wound care based on diagnosis
- Perform bedside wound care procedures including: debridement techniques, cleansing, dressings, pressure relief, pain control, and odor control
- Track the progress of wound healing
- Maintain accurate and timely documentation in electronic medical record
- Engage partner facility nurses to assist with wound care
- Collaborate with nursing, medical, and other healthcare team members regularly to ensure quality patient care
- Be a leader in motivating and encouraging patients and patient caregivers
- Provide clear direction to achieve goals, creating an environment that fosters team commitment and employee engagement
- Attend regularly scheduled team meetings, "Grand Rounds," for continued training, team building, and leadership development
- Other duties as assigned

**Minimum Requirements:**

- Must be punctual
- Reliable transportation
- Valid driver's license
- Current proof of auto insurance
- Clean driving record – must be able to provide 5 year driving abstract (MVR)

- Master's Degree – Board Certified Nurse Practitioner; licensed in working state (WA/OR/ID/UT)
- Active Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) license
- Knowledge of applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations including the requirements of the HIPAA and OSHA regulations pertinent to medical practices
- 1-2 years of wound care and/or surgical experience (highly preferred, but not required); extensive training available
- Ability to lead a team of healthcare providers within partner facilities
- Working experience with Microsoft Office products: Word, Outlook, Excel (intermediate knowledge)
- Must be dependable and able to work and schedule appointments independently
- Must be trustworthy, honest and have a positive and professional attitude
- Has a genuine, caring, and friendly personality that supports a positive work environment
- Has proven job skills and ability to organize priorities and work independently without supervision
- Ability to respond appropriately to constant change in priorities and services
- Must have strong interpersonal skills and the ability to communicate effectively with a variety of people through both verbal and written communication lines
- Excellent organizational and attention to detail skills

**Physical Requirements:**

This fast-paced position requires standing for extended amounts of time. Some lifting (up to 50lbs), bending, pulling, pushing, and reaching throughout the shift while fulfilling job requirements.
